Genesis 12:1-3 (NKJV) Now the Lord had said to Abram: “Get out of your country, From your family and from your father’s house, to a land that I will show you. I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

The blessing that God promised to Abram was conditional. The command was to get out of the place where he was living and leave his father’s house. He would no longer be subject to the traditions of families ties. He must now accept God as lord of his life. We also are promised a future in a land of God’s choice. Our future with God is also conditional.

Philippians 4:8-9 (NKJV) Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you.
